

Frequently Asked Questions

Who is eligible?

The scholarships will be available to students and adults who will be attending full-time, an accredited college, university, community college or trade school and who are Washington Financial customers or members of their immediate families.

What is the amount of the grant?

Washington Financial may award up to 10 scholarships, and the maximum amount of each scholarship is \$1,000 annually. Scholarships are granted on a one-year renewable basis up to a maximum of four consecutive years.

How are the scholarships granted?

After the winners are selected, each recipient must provide written verification from the educational institution they will be attending. The scholarship check will be made payable to both the student and school and mailed directly to the student. (For more information, please read "Eligibility Requirements.")

When are the winners announced?

Scholarship recipients are notified in May of the current year.

Where can you obtain an application or more information?

Scholarship information and applications are available both from your high school guidance counselor and by contacting Washington Financial's Headquarters' Office, 190 North Main Street, Washington, PA 15301.

Washington Financial realizes how difficult it can be to secure funding for advancing your education beyond high school. Whether you plan to attend a college, university, community college or trade school, the Washington Financial Scholarship Fund Program can help offset the costs of higher education. This program provides scholarships to eligible customers of Washington Financial or members of their immediate families. It's banking that's in your best interest.

The Scholarship Fund Program

Scholarships are available to students and adults who will be attending, full-time, an accredited college, university or trade school.

Scholarships are granted on a one-year renewable basis up to a maximum of four consecutive years. The maximum amount granted is \$1,000 annually.

Recipients must submit to Washington Financial verification of enrollment and an academic transcript to be eligible for payment.

The total dollar amount granted annually is determined by the number of qualified applicants.

Eligibility Requirements

1. The applicant, or a member of his/her immediate family, must be a Washington Financial customer. (Immediate family is defined as parent, child, grandchild, legal guardian or spouse). The customer relationship must be in effect for one full year prior to making application.
2. If the customer relationship ceases during the term of the scholarship award, all future payments will be forfeited.
3. Applicants must provide written verification of 100 hours of qualifying community service during the 12 months preceding the month of application.
(Qualifying service activities include those activities that support health and human service needs, community development and education. Volunteer hours for political campaigns do not qualify.)
4. The standard Washington Financial scholarship application form and all accompanying documents must be completed.
5. An applicant must maintain placement in the top 50% of his/her class (if currently a student).
6. Documentation of acceptance at an educational facility must be provided.
7. The Bank's Standard Grant Application/Financial Assistance Questionnaire must be completed.

Selection Process

1. Selection is based primarily on community service with priority given to those demonstrating the most significant financial need.
2. Financial information provided must come from the individual FAFSA form and remains confidential.
3. Applications must be submitted by April 1 to:

4. Applications must be complete and accompanied by community service verification and the most recent transcripts.
5. Awards will be presented at each school's awards ceremony.
